

Step by step tutorial: of Motorola Google Nexus 6 Audio connector

Step 1 - Motorola Nexus 6

Before starting, make sure that the equipment is turned off.





Remove the SIM tray.







Step 3 - Back cover

In this model we find that the back cover is fixed with adhesive. To detach it, we introduce the tip of a pick and go around the contour.















Holding the lid with a suction cup, we separate the lid by one of the sides, just enough to insert a flat plastic tool, which allows us to take off the center of the lid.


As you can see in the photographs, the adhesive occupies almost the entire surface. It is recommended to replace it before reinstalling the cover.





Step 5 - Intermediate housing

Remove the 22 Torx screws that hold the back cover.



Step 6

Remove the plastic cover and disconnect the flex from the battery.












Step 7

Use the prong to release the plastic hooks located on the contour of the housing.













Finally, take off the audio connector. You can push it with a pointed tool or use the spatula for it.
